The production facility at CWO Chichester workshops is able to produce a comprehensive range of stonework. The workshops are fully equipped with modern saws and machinery, and are operated by a highly trained and experienced workforce.

Worked Stone

CWO offer to supply a full range of worked stone in a wide selection of limestones and sandstones. Work is carried out by skilled banker masons at CWO's stonemasonry production facility in Chichester. Many of these craftsmen originally served their apprenticeship at CWO and have years of experience of working in stone.

Worked stone can be supplied in a whole range of hand finished designs, from ashlar and quoins, to traditional mullions, transomes, heads, cills, and tracery. Stonework for string courses, cornices, and coping stones can be worked to the most exacting requirements.

The CWO workshop is equipped with a lathe for turning stone balusters, finials, and other circular work. The supply of stone for plinths, parapets, and copings forms part of the standard production range.

CWO is also able to satisfy requirement for technically demanding stonework, including complex classical designs and architectural features, as well as stone carving and sculpture.

The design team will be pleased to discuss the choice of stone and assist with stone supply requirements generally. They are prepared to visit site and take sizes and measurements, and prepare drawings where necessary.
