

Private Residence, Weybridge, Surrey

CWO carried out the construction of a new Cantilever staircase, stone columns to the entrance hall of this new speculative build house in St Georges Hill, Weybridge.

The design brief was to create an impressive entrance to aid the sale of the property.

The architect approached CWO with plain outline sketches and copy of a photograph. From this CWO then submitted several design options to add shape and sculptural effect.

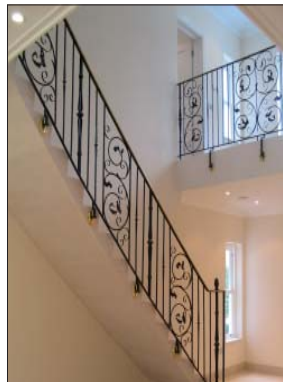
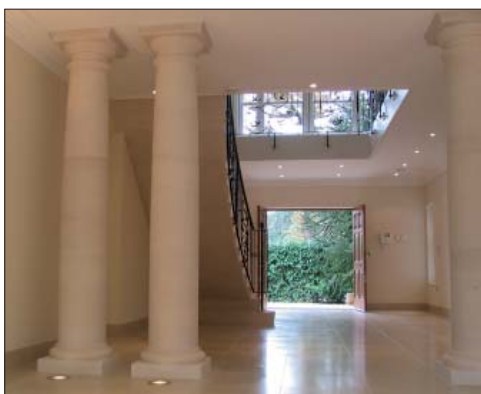
The final design, leads the eye upon entering, across the hallway and up the stairs, whilst from the rear and to the side the view through the Tuscan columns, of the slender string and the helix of the swept soffit, ensured a 'wow' factor from every viewpoint.



The mouldings of the treads are deliberately simple so as not to detract from the shape and the golden Balustrade is unashamedly 'bling'.

The stone selected for the project was Moca Crème (Portuguese) medium grained to add texture.

The preparation and production of the stone was carried out by masons at CWO's Chichester workshop and dispatched to the site, where our masons completed the installation, fixing the stairs and columns in a three-week contract period.
