Goodwood Golf Club, Chichester



The Goodwood Golf Club is situated within the Goodwood Estate owned by The Earl of March. The buildings, designed in 1787 by the architect James Wyatt, are described as the finest example of Sussex flintwork in the country. The interior today has seen modifications to accommodate the growing club, but the building's exterior remained intact.

CWO carried the specialist stonework packages which comprised of the new internal Portland stone floors to the lobby and corridors. Externally fitting new Portland stone front steps, walls and paving.

Re-laying external re-claimed York paving as well as supplied and fixed new Portland stone copings to new Pro-shop and kitchen.

CWO supplied and fixed Moca Crème stone flooring to Pro-shop to match the new Ralph Laurent designed interior.

The front and rear pediments were taken down and rebuilt as they were structurally unsound, taking care that the existing terracotta Coat of Arms were protected and not disturbed.

Externally CWO also carried out the Doff cleaning to front and rear elevations as well as minor stone repairs and re-pointing.
